The gift of opportunity

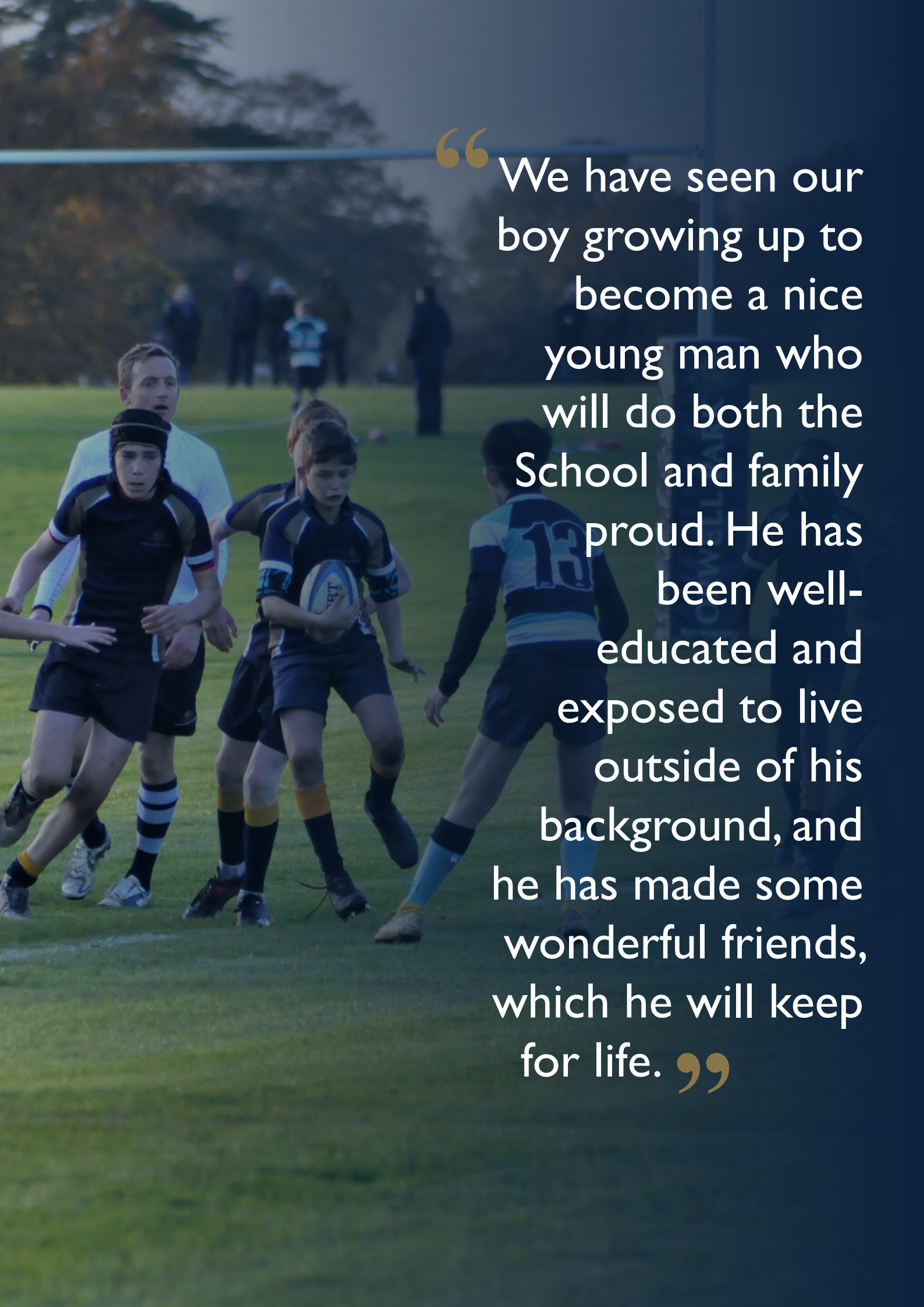
The Orwell Park Foundation is currently seeking donations towards our Bursary Fund. This fund opens up unique opportunities to those able and motivated pupils whose home background would otherwise exclude them from a learning environment like Orwell's.

The pupils who receive these bursaries are exceptionally grateful, and make enthusiastic and conscientious students. Many go on to top independent senior schools such as Eton, and speak of the **transformational experience** that a place at Orwell has been for them. It has enabled them to fulfil their potential, to form lifelong friendships, and to experience music, sports, classics, DT, and other subjects that they would not have had access to otherwise, to say nothing of receiving top-quality teaching across the more 'mainstream' subjects such as English, maths, science and languages.

Currently very little of the School's bursary provision is subsidised by donations, but in order to continue to grow this area of support, and to enable the School to invest in other vital projects as well, we are seeking supporters who are passionate about enabling more disadvantaged young people to experience a **fantastic education**.

Over the next 3 years we are seeking £250,000, which would have a transformational impact on the lives of many young people. Supporters can come on board for a fixed period such as 2, 5 or 10 years, or can make a one-off gift, and contributions towards this sum - large or small - are **hugely appreciated**.
